OVERVIEW:

The Climax Harness Veleta (SKU CLX2014) is robust personal protective equipment (PPE) designed for safe working at heights where there is a risk of falling. With both dorsal (rear) and frontal anchorage points, this full-body harness supports fall-arrest systems as well as positioning and suspension tasks. Its padded waist belt, leg loops and back panel enhance comfort during prolonged use, and its adjustability ensures a secure, ergonomic fit. Ideal for construction, maintenance, rope-access, and other industrial applications, the Veleta harness meets modern safety standards and delivers reliable performance where height safety is required.

DETAILS:

Key Features:

Rear (dorsal) anchorage point ("A") and frontal anchorage point ("A/2") for fall arrest systems.

Lateral positioning buckles on sides (in some versions) to secure work positioning belt.

Padded waist belt, leg loops and back panel for comfort during suspension and movement.

Polyester webbing and components built to meet EN 361 (fall arrest) and (work positioning) standards.

Side rings or loops for tool-holding/attachments (in enhanced versions).

How to Use:

Before use, inspect the harness for wear, damage, frayed webbing, missing stitching, or corroded buckles.

Step into the leg loops and pull the waist belt up around your hips; adjust the leg loops to fit snugly.

Secure the chest strap and adjust shoulder straps so the dorsal anchorage point sits between your shoulder blades.

Use the frontal chest anchorage point if your work requires front attachment (e.g., rope access, descent, or work-positioning).

Connect your fall-arrest lanyard or rope system to the appropriate anchorage point, compatible with the job's risk assessment.

Ensure the harness is snug but allows full freedom of movement. Avoid twisting of straps or webbing.
